The project officially began on August 12, 2025, with the installation of the first solar panel stand. Recently, JSC "Azerenerji" and the Azerbaijan Ministry of Finance signed a loan agreement with the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD), a. Azerbaijan has approved the construction of two new solar plants totaling 760 MW in the southeastern part of the country. (Masdar) will oversee the development of the projects. Baku, The Gulf Observer: The Government of the Republic of Azerbaijan signed key investment and implementation agreements for three new solar energy projects as part of the 11th Southern Gas Corridor Advisory Council Ministerial Meeting and the 3rd Green Energy Advisory Council Ministerial Meeting. Azerbaijan is undergoing a significant energy transformation, shifting its focus from a traditional hydrocarbon-based economy to a future powered by renewable sources.
