There are three train stations in Zagreb. Below is the list and a detailed guide on. Zagreb International Airport (ZAG) is situated in the district of Pleso, about 20km south-east from the city centre. Croations Airlines have also increased their services to and from the airport and offer very good value. Zagreb has one main central station which handles all mainline trains to & from Zagreb, Zagreb Glavni kolodvor, which simply means Zagreb main station. 62 mi) south of the city's main square, [1] it is the largest station in Croatia and the main hub of the Croatian Railways network. 

Zagreb Glavni kolodvor (Croatian for Zagreb main station) is the main railway station in Zagreb, Croatia. Located 1 km (0.62 mi) south of the city's main square, it is the largest station in Croatia and the main hub of the Croatian Railways network.
