



How to supply power to the base station if the power is off





Overview

In case of a power outage, shutting down a wireless base station is not an option. IF you are only connecting one radio (up to 50 watts) to the power supply then any 30 amp supply will work. I have several power supplies; an old Astron 30 Amp, two R&L Electronics brand 30 Amp supplies, and a Tek-Power 50. Mobile as base station--How do I power this thing?

Recently bought a Midland MXT115 for use as an indoors base station--I like that if power goes out I could connect it to my 12v car jump starter/power pack. When a power failure happens the load side just reverts to the input with power. At home, I currently run a mobile 2m/70cm radio and a Kenwood TS-430S 160-10m radio off of a power supply. I have a Uniden 980SSB and a 100w kicker running to a A-99. Each of these systems is in turn divided into smaller sections and.

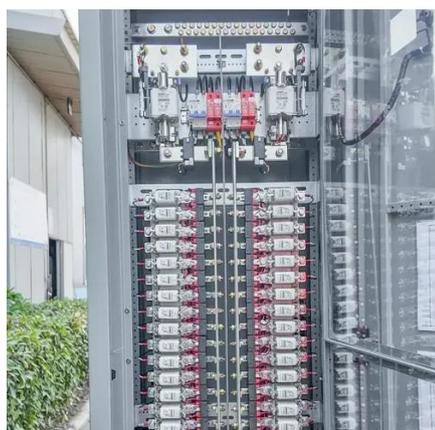

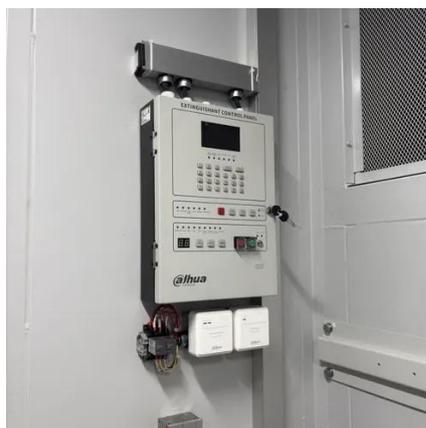


Anyone ever run a base station off grid?
