



# Huchang photovoltaic panel collapse





## Overview

---

China's solar industry is teetering on the brink of collapse, hit hard by punitive U. tariffs and a severe domestic supply glut. The crisis stems from a growth model heavily reliant on government subsidies, with little regard for technological preparedness. The recent SNEC PV Conference in Shanghai reflected this gloom, with fewer attendees. A government-driven factory boom (2020–2023) has backfired, flooding the market with solar panels—twice global demand—collapsing prices and leading to a \$60 billion industry loss. While central authorities push to shut inefficient factories and curb "disorderly competition," local governments are. China's solar manufacturers have just been through a bloodbath of an earnings season, but there are tentative signs the massive glut that is plaguing the industry could be starting to ease. The top four manufacturers (LONGi, Jinko Solar, Trina Solar, JA Solar) alone lost \$1. 54 billion in the first half of 2025. The sector's total losses reached. Mary Ann Jones, 83, didn't realize this had happened to her until she received a call last year from GoodLeap, a financial technology company, saying she owed \$52,564.

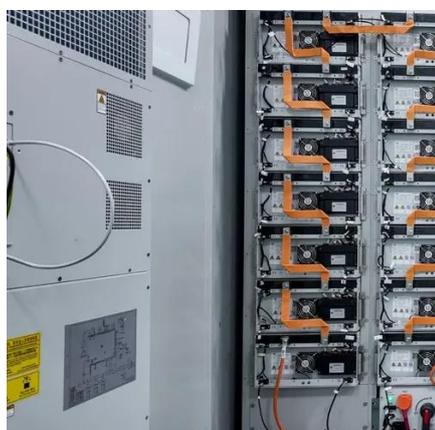
