It's likely a scam. Usually, what the company means is that the installation itself is free, and sometimes that there will. If you've received an offer for "free solar panels," it could be a scam. Always look for businesses you can trust - like Accredited Businesses using the BBB Seal. Scammers often advertise "\$0 down. Scammers across the U. are going door-to-door, pitching "free" solar energy systems. The criminals are leaving unsuspecting homeowners with massive debt; many victims have reported losing tens of

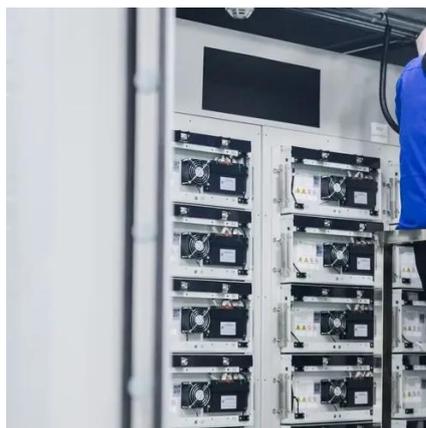
